Special Skills: strong group management

Other Requirements: clear walk with the Lord; small group teaching; minimum age 16

Reports To: Staff Manager, Camp Director

Who You Serve: The campers and camp staff

Role: to prepare and oversee your specific activity; to be familiar with the Biblical Truth connected to each activity and be prepared to share this with each group

Specific Responsibilities:

Crafts Leader

- Attend training
- Check in with Staff Manager
- Be on site ahead of Group's arrival
- Prepare and check all equipment/area
- Lead and demonstrate the activity, sharing any relevant Biblical Truths outlined in Activity Handbook/training
- Oversee safe use of equipment.
- Direct Team Leaders and Guides as to how they are to help.
- Direct Team Leaders and Guides to be sure that each craft is labeled with camper name and group
- Place craft in assigned group boxes.
- Clean up area after each session
- Assist in distribution of finished crafts.
- Check inventory and let Manager know of any supply needs
- Check in with Staff Manager before leaving site or moving to new activity

Obstacle Course

- Attend training
- Check in with Staff Manager
- Be on site before Group's arrival
- Prepare and check all equipment
- Share relevant Biblical truths outlined in Activity Handbook/training

- Lead Activity: demonstrate as necessary; ensure turn taking; create variation (timed runs; beating personal times etc)
- Oversee Camper safety as a top priority
- Direct Team Leaders and Guides to spot Campers throughout course
- Check all equipment after Group leaves
- Check in with Staff Manager before leaving site or moving to a new Activity

Zip line

- Attend training
- Check in with Staff Manager
- Be on site before Group's arrival
- Prepare and check all equipment/area
- Share relevant Biblical truths outlined in Activity Handbook/training
- Lead activity: proper and safe use of harnesses and helmets; attaching Campers to the zipline; double checking safe and proper attachment; turn taking etc
- Direct Team Leaders and Guides to assist in the safe use of the zipline
- Oversee Camper safety as a top priority
- Check all equipment and area after Group leaves
- Check in with Staff Manager before leaving site or moving to a new Activity

Scavenger Hike

- Attend training
- Check in with Staff Manager
- Be on site before Group's arrival
- Prepare and check equipment/area
- Share relevant Biblical Truths as outlined in the Activity Handbook/training
- Lead activity: use scavenger hunt sheets/egg cartons to add purpose to the trail hike; name and explain the various items and link to Creation
- Direct Team Leaders and Guides as to how they can help
- Ensure Camper safety as a top priority
- Show and tell campers about specific plants or creation facts and involve them in finding specific things
- Check all equipment and area after Group leaves
- Inform Manager of any supply needs (scavenger hunt sheets, egg cartons, pencils etc)
- Check in with Staff Manager before leaving site or moving to next Activity

Gardening

- Attend training
- Check in with Staff Manager
- Be on site before Group's arrival
- Prepare and check equipment/area
- Share relevant Biblical Truths as outlined in the Activity Handbook/training
- Lead activity: plant and water seeds/seedlings
- Direct Team Leaders and Guides as to how they can help
- Ensure Camper safety as a top priority
- Show and tell campers about specific plants or creation facts as outlined in Activity Handbook/training
- Check all equipment and area after Group leaves
- Inform Manager of any supply needs
- Check in with Staff Manager before leaving site or moving to next Activity

Archery

- Attend training
- Check in with Staff Manager
- Be on site before Group's arrival
- Prepare and check equipment/area
- Share relevant Biblical Truths as outlined in the Activity Handbook/training
- Lead activity: how to hold and load a bow; how to pull back and release; how to safely remove arrows from targets
- Direct Team Leaders and Guides as to how they can help
- Share safety procedures BEFORE activity starts
- Ensure Camper safety as a top priority
- Check all equipment and area after Group leaves
- Put all equipment away in designated area
- Inform Manager of any supply needs
- Check in with Staff Manager before leaving site or moving to next Activity

Fishing Instructor

- Attend training
- in with Staff Manager
- Be on site before Group's arrival
- Prepare and check equipment/area
- Share relevant Biblical Truths as outlined in the Activity Handbook/Training

- Share safety procedures BEFORE activity starts
- Lead activity: demonstrate how to cast and reel; attach bait; remove fish
- Direct Team Leaders and Guides as to how they can help
- Ensure Camper safety as a top priority
- Check all equipment and area after Group leaves
- Inform Manager of any supply needs
- Check in with Staff Manager before leaving site or moving to next Activity

Wilderness Instructor

- Attend training
- Check in with Staff Manager
- Be on site before Group's arrival
- Prepare and check equipment/area
- Share relevant Biblical Truths as outlined in the Activity Handbook/training
- Share safety procedures BEFORE activity starts
- Lead activity: 10 essentials; knots; fire building; shelter building; survival skills
- Direct Team Leaders and Guides as to how they can help
- Ensure Camper safety as a top priority
- Check all equipment and area after Group leaves
- Inform Manager of any supply needs
- Check in with Staff Manager before leaving site or moving to next Activity

Outdoor Pursuits

- Attend training
- Check in with Staff Manager
- Be on site before Group's arrival
- Prepare and check equipment/area
- Share relevant Biblical Truths as outlined in the Activity Handbook/training
- Share safety procedures BEFORE activity starts
- Lead activity: bouldering wall; creek walk; scavenger hike
- Direct Team Leaders and Guides as to how they can help
- Ensure Camper safety as a top priority
- Check all equipment and area after Group leaves
- Inform Manager of any supply needs
- Check in with Staff Manager before leaving site or moving to next Activity

Water Safety Officer

- Attend training
- Check in with Staff Manager
- Be on site before Group's arrival
- Prepare and check equipment/swim area
- Ensure lifeguards are on site BEFORE anyone enters the water
- Direct Team Leaders and Guides to various positions (dock; safety boat; beach; lifejacket shed etc)
- Ensure Camper safety as a top priority
- Check all equipment and area after Group leaves
- Inform Manager of any supply needs
- Check in with Staff Manager before leaving site or moving to next Activity
